

Senior Project PowerPoint Guidelines

You will have 5 minutes to tell us about your senior project, followed by 2 minutes for questions from your professors and peers, for a total of 7 minutes per student.

In your 5 minutes, you will use a PowerPoint presentation to describe:

1. The title and topic of your project
2. Your methodological plan
3. Your findings (hypothesized, preliminary, or final).
4. If you are graduating in the Social Studies Division, you'll describe the literature and sources you're using, and provide an overview of your argument.

It is important to go over your presentation with your advisor beforehand. Be prepared, and make effective use of each slide.

Be sure to practice your presentation so that you do not go over 5 minutes. The schedule will be emailed out several weeks before the presentations. If you have class during your assigned time, let the Program Chair (Kristin Lane) know immediately and a switch will be arranged. Plan to stay the entire time, listen to your peers' presentations, offer support, and ask questions.

All presentations will be run off Moodle - you will upload your presentation to Moodle by 10:30am on Thursday [February 9th](#). The Moodle site is called "Psychology Program," and the enrollment key is "PsychPreston". Upload your presentation with YOUR LAST NAME IN THE TITLE OF THE FILE. Calling it "senior project powerpoint" will make it impossible to find when your turn to present arrives.
